An intensive two-day laparoscopic course designed to enrich essential knowledge and skills required to perform intermediate and advanced level safe Laparoscopic Gynaecological practice. It covers key theoretical aspects and ample hands-on experience in common Gynaecological procedures on laparoscopic models.

Who should attend?

Trainees, Consultant Gynaecologists and doctors of any grade who are keen to develop intermediate and advanced laparoscopic skills for day-to-day Gynaecological practice.

Theoretical lectures –

Very few small lectures on the basics of laparoscopy, energy sources, dissection, suturing principles, safe practice to avoid complications and to identify and manage these complications in laparoscopic surgery.

Hands-On Workstations -

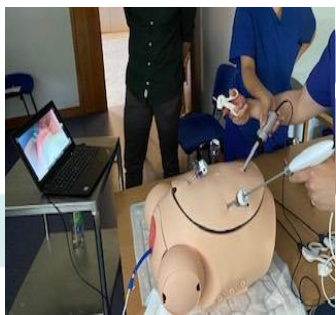
Delegate seeking intermediate skills will be paired with a delegate seeking advanced skills for each laprotrainer model. Each pair will have ample opportunity for hand on practice on the laprotrainer –

Basic skills – Threading, stacking, sorting

Intermediate skills – Salpingectomy and Salpingotomy; Ovarian Cystectomy & Oophorectomy

Advanced skills – Myomectomy, Total laparoscopic hysterectomy, Intra and extra-corporeal suturing.

Laprotrainer and simulators and uterine models are being provided by Karl Storz, Applied, Ethicon and Cooper surgical with plenty of hands-on opportunity to do hysterectomy, vault suturing, myomectomy, extensive practice on suturing. There will be additional display stands with advance instruments from the sponsors.
